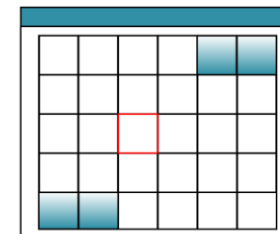
If you would like to come and help in the nursery please add your name to the calendar available on the information board.

Naming clothes

Please could you ensure that your child's clothes, jackets, bags etc are named and they have a full change of clothes everyday.

It is the school policy, when a child has an injury to their face or head regardless of the severity; we are required to make a phone call home. Orange group- borrowing library (new Location)

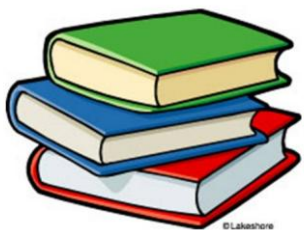
Wellington boots and Waterproofs
