- **Snack** - Recently we have had a number of children bringing snacks in their bags. These are then being shared with other children or are being taken from bags. We fully understand that at the end of the day your child may want a snack to eat on the way home. Can we ask that you bring this with you rather than put it in the child's bag. Thank you.

By working with adults and their children, PEEP supports parents and carers in their role as the first educators of their children. We would love to welcome you along. Spaces are limited so if you would like to join in please speak to Mrs Rao who is our PEEP leader
